The **school day will start at 8.30am and finish at 3.30** pm for Reception, Year 1 and year 2. Monday to Thursday and on **Fridays school will finish at 1pm for all year groups**. main playground, through the green gates. **Reception children** will be dropped off through the reception garden but picked up from the main playground as we do now.
