WHAT TO BRING?

ALL STUDENTS must bring:

- A pen
- **Proof of identity, which must be one of the following:**
 - Passport
 - Biometric Residence Permit
 - Birth Certificate
 - Adoption Certificate
 - National Insurance Card
 - National Identity Card
 - Bank Credit/Debit Card showing full name
- If possible, please bring your current school report and attendance record.
- Evidence of all of your current qualifications, including your GCSE results slips. (If you haven't achieved English and Maths at grade 4 and above, then this information will be used to ensure you are enrolled on to an appropriate level of English and Maths. Your enrolment will not be complete until you have provided these results.)

If you are AGED 19 OR OLDER you must also bring:

- **Proof of identity, which must be one of the following:**
 - Driving Licence
 - Marriage Certificate
 - HM Forces ID Card
 - Proof Of Age Standards Scheme Card (with official PASS logo)
 - Certificate of Entitlement to Funding
 - National ID Card (not the College Learner Pass)
- Proof of Universal Credit, Job Seekers Allowance letter (JSA) or Employment Support Allowance letter (ESA) in the work related activity group (including partner where the claim is joint). If you are unemployed, please bring proof of any other benefits that you receive.
- Your chosen method for paying your fees. You can pay for your course in full or the first payment of an instalment plan by credit or debit card (no cheque or cash please). Subsequent instalment payments will be by direct debit or your letter confirming Student Loan Approval from Student Finance England (if applicable).



If your employer is paying for your course, they must complete the 'Agreement to pay course fees on behalf of a student' form which can be collected from the Customer Advice and Support Centre. Alternatively, you can bring with you a letter from your employer on letter headed paper stating:

- Your name
- Course title
- Confirmation of amount to pay
- Details of where the invoice should be sent
- Name and signature of the authorising persons
- Purchase Order number (if required)

If you are a **NON EU STUDENT** bring:

- Proof of residency, e.g. passport, visa, residence permit (proof of residency must be valid and in date)

In addition to this, if a Special Educational Need (SEN) or Education, Health and Care Plan (EHCP) is declared during the enrolment process you will be invited in again for a needs assessment to ensure we can meet any support needs prior to completing your enrolment.
