Creating a safer environment outside schools - School Safe Haven cameras.

Walsall Council have notified us that they have now installed a 'School Safe Haven' camera to promote a safer environment around the school gates by reducing congestion. The Council hope this camera will improve driver behaviour and encourage motorists to reconsider the need to drive to school. The cameras will

be in operation during school terms and will only be used for enforcement purposes in the keep clear restriction periods, which can be seen on the yellow regulatory signs. These cameras have nothing to do with school but are the result of longstanding parking and safety issues that have been a concern to Walsall for some time. 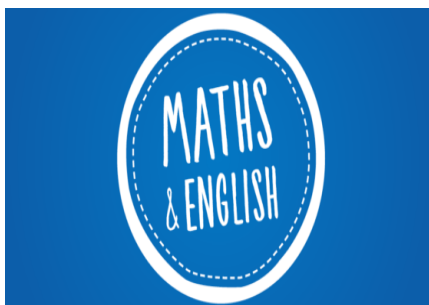


Free Adult Advice and Guidance: Walsall College
